Door Monitor Duties 2005

Your job is very important. We want the matches to run smoothly, without unnecessary interruption. Generally, once a match has begun no one is allowed to enter the competition room. However, some people are allowed to enter.

If someone comes to you and wants to come in after the start of the match, you should ask the following questions:

- Name?
- Position with the Academic Bowl?
- Position with the host school or Gallaudet University?

If the individual is on the posted list, you can let them in. Quietly, please.
(This list will be posted at each competition room.)

If the individual is a family member, friend, volunteer not on duty in that room or from a team not competing in the room at the time, they will have to wait until the next match to enter.

Remember to smile, be polite but firm.

After the match is over, collect the official score report from the Room Coordinator and deliver it to the person(s) who post the scores.

Be prepared to run an errand if the Room Coordinator, GURC or Host Coordinator(s) ask you to.

If there are any concerns you should talk to the GU/GURC Room Coordinator.
