20 possible bonus questions	2 points each correct answer	30 seconds-math 20 seconds-non-math
<u>Round 2:</u> 20 questions	2 points each correct answer	20 seconds
<u>Final Round:</u> 15 questions for team discussion	3 points each correct answer	3 minutes
