### NEW METHOD OF NOMINATING OFFICERS

In other action at the last meeting of the board of directors, a new method of nominating members as candidates for election to the board of directors was decided upon. It was felt that this will shorten greatly the time which is usually taken in the election of officers, and will, at the same time, give everyone a fair chance to nominate at least one member of the board. (Each member thus may endorse or nominate only one candidate.)

Nominations must be made in writing, and each nomination must have three active members endorsing it. These written nominations must be handed to or mailed to the elections committee (R. G. Sanderson, chairman) at least two weeks prior to the convention. Thus the deadline for nominations to the board is Friday, May 10.

A member may nominate himself, but he must have three other signatures of active members. A member may nominate anyone he or she chooses--if the nominee accepts! (Don't waste your only nomination on someone who will not accept.)

The nomination form should be as follows:

"We herewith nominate \_\_\_\_\_ as a candidate for election to the board of directors." (Three Signatures.)

The elections committee will provide voting ballots for each registered member at the convention.

Remember! Get your nominations in before Friday, May 10. This is the only notice you will get.
